World Council for Islamic Call Sub-organization of the Libyan Islamic Call Society. Established in 1982 as a competitor to the Saudi-based World Muslim League. Advocates for Muammar Qaddafi's Third Universal Alternative and Libyan foreign policy. Meets annually. Thirty-six members are elected by the Conference for the Islamic Mission. Concerned with the international impact of the Islamic Call Society's role as point of contact for Islamic communities worldwide.
