Between 2002 and 2005, he was in-charge of the studies at the UdeM where he taught translation at the Master's department. Between 2005 and 2008, he became regular professor at the school of translation and interpretation at the University of Ottawa. His field of interest is the translation studies in general, the philosophy of translation, ethics and translation, translation and politics, language and Koran translation, the exile figures in the Arabic and French speaking literatures and the occidental Muslim thought in the middle and modern ages.
